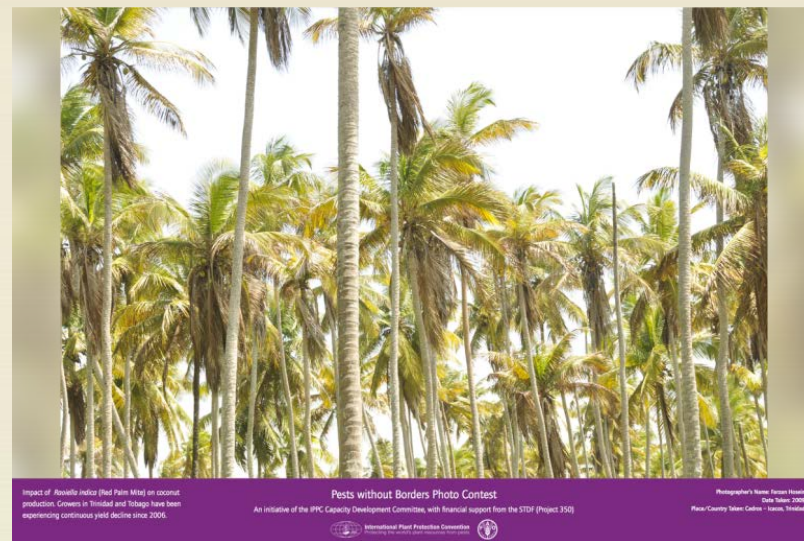

PRELIMINARY OUTPUTS OF THE IYPH 2020 (1)

- Increased public awareness about plant health (numbers of popular publications, articles, etc.)
- More political support to NPPOs
- Improved capacity through more plant health related projects
- Commitments on sustainable financing of national plant health systems
- Greater participation of developing countries in international trade



PRELIMINARY OUTPUTS OF THE IYPH 2020 (2)



- Increased donor commitments to IPPC and plant health capacity building
- Increased reflection of phytosanitary matters in national academic curricula
- Greater stakeholder involvement in national plant health decision-making
- Strengthened RPPOs
- Establishment of the 6th December 2021 as an international day of plant health
