Roles of RW Organizing Committees

Co-organizers

liaise with contracting parties to comment on the draft Agenda.

provide the facilities needed for the workshop.

provide additional logistical arrangements, as agreed with the IPPC Secretariat.

provide funds or help mobilize resources.

Each organizing committee and participant is encouraged to help secure funding for their workshop





Conclusions and Discussions about IPPC Regional Workshops

Regional Workshop Organizing Committee

A regional workshop
organizing committee

Nominates an individual(s) with the appropriate expertise to attend the workshop.

Mobilizes resources (full or at least partial) for the attendance of the designated participant.

Ensures that the participant selected to represent the NPPO in the workshop has analyzed the draft ISPMs and other documents before attending the workshop, and has completed preworkshop exercises

Ensures the NPPO's comments on draft ISPMs are entered into the Online Comment System(OCS) before the workshop.

After the workshop and by 30 September, provides additional NPPO's comments on draft ISPMs to the IPPC Secretariat, and submits at least one general comment for each draft ISPM.



Conclusions and Discussions about IPPC Regional Workshops

Invitation of Resource Persons by the Organizing Committee

The organizing committee may agree to invite resource persons

Including Bureau members, stewards or experts from their regions or other regions and they may participate in discussions. Resource persons should not influence discussions on regional issues, particularly comments on draft ISPMs.

Observers from relevant international organizations and NPPOs outside the region. Observers should not influence discussions on regional issues, particularly comments on draft ISPMs.

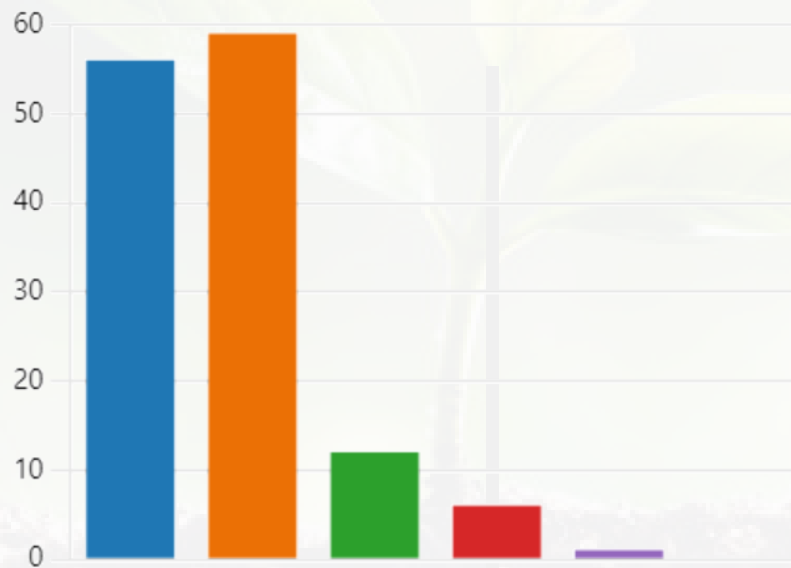

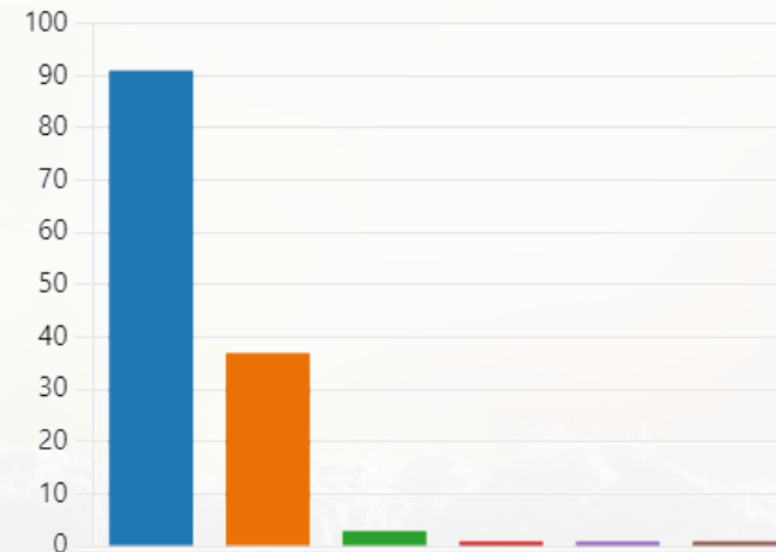
