1. Table 1 provides a brief overview of the various stages in the IPPC standard setting procedure and defines abbreviations used in this document.
2. The charts provided in Attachments 1, 2 and 3 show the various topics (including draft International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPMs), diagnostic protocols and phytosanitary treatments) that were worked on in 2012. This information paper should be used in conjunction with the CPM 2013/05 paper entitled: List of Topics for IPPC Standards
3. The shaded cells indicate which topics were worked on in 2012 as well as the progress made on their development.
4. Diagnostic protocols and phytosanitary treatments in the advanced stage of development (after member consultation) are listed separately, while those prior to the member consultation stage are grouped under their respective topics.
5. In 2012, the IPPC Secretariat worked on Russian translations of adopted ISPMs.
6. The chart in Attachment 4 gives an overview of the technical panel and expert working group meetings, both virtual and face-to-face, that were held in 2012.
