# COMMISSION ON PHYTOSANITARY MEASURES

Seventh Session

Adoption of international standards: special process - annexes (DPs and PTs)

## I. INTRODUCTION

1. This document presents two diagnostic protocols and four phytosanitary treatments which the Standards Committee (SC) recommends for adoption by the Commission on Phytosanitary Measures (CPM):

- Attachment 1: Diagnostic protocol for *Plum pox virus* (2004-007)
- Attachment 2: Diagnostic protocols for *Trogoderma granarium* (2004-006)

2. Phytosanitary Treatments for Fruit flies:

- Attachment 3: Cold treatment for *Bactrocera tryoni* on *Citrus sinensis* (2007-206E)
- Attachment 4: Cold treatment for *Bactrocera tryoni* on *Citrus reticulata* x *C. sinensis* (2007-206F)
- Attachment 5: Cold treatment for *Ceratitis capitata* on *Citrus paradisi* (2007-210)
- Attachment 6: Cold treatment for *Ceratitis capitata* on *Citrus reticulata* cultivars and hybrids (2007-212)

3. If no formal objection is received up to 14 days prior to the CPM meeting, the draft standard will be adopted without discussion. If a formal objection is received up to 14 days prior to the CPM meeting, the draft standard is returned to the SC. The SC will decide how to proceed, including the possibility of submitting it to the CPM for adoption through the regular process. Formal objections should be submitted to the Secretariat ([ippc@fao.org](mailto:ippc@fao.org)) along with a detailed explanation. The IPPC Secretariat will post formal objections on the International Phytosanitary Portal (IPP) as soon as possible to ensure that contracting parties are aware of them before the CPM meeting.

A. Diagnostic protocol for *Plum pox virus* (2004-007) as an annex to ISPM 27. 2006. (*Diagnostic protocols for regulated pests*)

4. The SC added the diagnostic protocol for *Plum pox virus* (2004-007) to the *List of topics for IPPC standards* in November 2004 under the topic *Viruses and phytoplasmas* (2006-009). The Technical panel on diagnostic protocols (TPDP) first reviewed the draft at its 2006 meeting and finalized it by email in 2008. The SC approved the draft for member consultation in September 2008 by e-mail, and submitted it for member consultation in June 2010. The IPPC Secretariat received 298 member comments on the draft. The TPDP reviewed the comments and revised the draft via e-mail in 2011. Via e-decision in October 2011, the SC recommended the draft to the CPM.

B. Diagnostic protocol for *Trogoderma granarium* (2004-006) as an annex to ISPM 27:2006

5. The SC added the diagnostic protocol for *Trogoderma granarium* (2004-006) to the *List of topics for IPPC standards* in November 2004 under the topic *Insects and mites* (2006-007). The TPDP first reviewed the draft at its 2005 meeting and finalized it by email in 2008. The SC approved the draft for member consultation in September 2008 by e-mail, and submitted it for member consultation in June 2011. The IPPC Secretariat received 364 comments on the draft. The TPDP reviewed the comments and revised the draft by e-mail in 2011. Via e-decision in December 2011-January 2012, the SC recommended the draft to the CPM.

C. Fruit fly treatments as annexes to ISPM 28. 2007. (*Phytosanitary treatments for regulated pests*)

6. The SC added the topic *Fruit fly treatments* (2006-024) under the Technical panel on phytosanitary treatments (TPPT) in May 2006. In 2007, the IPPC Secretariat held a call for subjects under fruit fly treatments, and, at its meeting in December 2007, the TPPT evaluated cold treatments for fruit flies in response to the 2007 call. The SC (November 2008) added the eight cold treatments to the List of topics for IPPC Standards. After an SC e-decision in May 2009, and text was further revised by the TPPT, the SC approved the eight treatments for member consultation. These treatments (listed below) were sent for member consultation in June 2009:

- Cold treatment of *Citrus sinensis* for *Ceratitis capitata* (2007-106A/2007-206A)
- Cold treatment of *Citrus reticulata* × *Citrus sinensis* for *Ceratitis capitata* (2007-106B/2007-206B)
- Cold treatment of *Citrus limon* for *Ceratitis capitata* (2007-106C/2007-206C)
- Cold treatment of *Citrus sinensis* for *Bactrocera tryoni* (2007-106E/2007-206E)
- Cold treatment of *Citrus reticulata* × *Citrus sinensis* for *Bactrocera tryoni* (2007-106F/2007-206F)
- Cold treatment of *Citrus limon* for *Bactrocera tryoni* (2007-106G/2007-206G)
- Cold treatment of *Citrus paradisi* for *Ceratitis capitata* (2007-110/2007-210)
- Cold treatment of *Citrus reticulata* cultivars and hybrids for *Ceratitis capitata* (2007-112/2007-212).

7. The IPPC Secretariat received a total of 218 comments for all eight treatments. At its 2010 July meeting<sup>1</sup>, the TPPT discussed the responses to comments and revised the draft treatments. The TPPT finalized the draft cold treatments via email in August 2010. The Secretariat sent the eight treatments for SC e-decision in August 2011 to recommend the treatments with a recommendation for adoption by the CPM. In October 2011, via e-decision, the SC recommended only four of the eight treatments.

8. The following treatments are recommended to the CPM for adoption:

- 1) Cold treatment for *Bactrocera tryoni* on *Citrus sinensis* (2007-206E)

- 2) Cold treatment for *Bactrocera tryoni* on *Citrus reticulata* x *C. sinensis* (2007- 206F)
  - 3) Cold treatment for *Ceratitis capitata* on *Citrus paradisi* (2007-210)
  - 4) Cold treatment for *Ceratitis capitata* on *Citrus reticulata* cultivars and hybrids (2007-212)

12. *Adopt*, as annexes to ISPM 28: 2007, four fruit fly treatments, listed below and contained in Attachments 3 through 6 to this paper:
