New import phytosanitary requirements implemented in 2014 – 2017

- Importation of 9 items of processed and dried for consumption soy bean (Glycine max), corn/maize grain (Zea mays), dried for consumption cocoa bean (Theobroma cacao), processed and dried for consumption coffee beans (Coffea Arabica, Robusta coffee, Coffea liberica), fresh/dried leaves tobacco (Nicotiana tabacum), fresh/raw dried cotton (Gossypium hirsutum), fresh orange and lime (Citrus spp.), fresh banana (Musa spp.) and all plant-based commodities intended for livestock or animal feed (such as hay, straw, corn cob, skin cocoa, sago etc.)
 - The new import measures:
 - i. Import permit from DOA Malaysia;
 - ii. Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) from the exporting country;
 - iii. Full implementation starting from 1st January 2015.
- 2. Importation of fresh mangosteen (Garcinia mangostana)
 - The new import measures:
 - i. Import permit from DOA Malaysia;
 - ii. Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) from the exporting country;
 - iii. Full implementation starting from 1st November 2015.
- 3. Importation of all types of fresh chillies (Capsicum annum/Capsicum frutescens), fresh betel leaf (Piper betle) and fresh durian (Durio zibethinus)
 - The new import measures:
 - i. Import permit from DOA Malaysia;
 - ii. Phytosanitary Certificate (PC) from the exporting country;
 - iii. Full implementation starting from 1st March 2017.
