

# EXPORT/IMPORT REQUIREMENTS


## THE EXPORT REQUIREMENT INVOLVES;

- Apply for Phytosanitary Certificate from Plant Protection Services Section.
- Consignment (s) is inspected prior to exportation.
- Inspection and weighing of consignment (s).
- Treatment of consignment (s), depending on the requirements for phytosanitary measures of the importing country.
- Issue Phytosanitary Certificate in conformity of the phytosanitary measures of the importing country.

## THE IMPORT REQUIREMENT INVOLVES;

- Apply for a Plant Import Permit from Plant Protection Services Section before importing the goods.
- Forward the Plant Import Permit to the supplier.
- Supplier complies with Plant Import Permit condition and obtained Phytosanitary Certificate.
- Declare for inspection and verification of documents to plant quarantine officer (s) at the point of entry.
- Release/pending/Confiscate with regards to phytosanitary documentation checks, verification of consignment integrity, inspection and testing.
