Regarding travel assistance and funding, donors have made limited funds available to assist participants from developing countries with travel costs. Funds will be provided only to those participants willing to agree to the conditions regarding participation stipulated by the donor.

Those participants who fall under the IPPC criteria to receive travel assistance are invited to submit their request no later than **11 September 2012**.

Please also note that this year FAO has changed its policy on providing daily subsistence allowance (DSA) for accommodation. In accordance with these new rules (the Preferred Hotel Programme (PHP)), the IPPC Secretariat will now arrange for hotel bookings and pay this accommodation directly for the participants eligible for IPPC Secretariat funding. As accommodation is provided for directly, the DSA amount will be reduced by the corresponding portion that is allocated for accommodation.
