- CPM-12 (2017) agreed Implementation and Capacity Development Committee (IC) be established
- IC met December 2017 and May 2018



Purpose

- Develop, monitor and oversee an integrated programme to support the implementation of the Convention, International Standards for Phytosanitary Measures (ISPMs) and CPM Recommendations
- Strengthen the phytosanitary capacity of Contracting Parties

Work Procedures: IC Sub-groups

- IC agreed to establish three IC Sub-groups¹:
 - Dispute Avoidance and Settlement
 - Implementation, Review and Support System (IRSS)
 - Sea Container Task Force (SCTF)
- Consultation on IC Sub-groups draft Terms of Reference and draft Rules of Procedure conducted²
- Procedure Manual for Implementation and Capacity Development is currently being developed
