

# 3. General Information and Travel Requirements

#### **3.1. Visas**

Peru is basically a country of open doors. The entry into Peru for Citizens of most American and Western European countries does not require a tourist visa. The maximum period of stay granted by the authorities is 183 days (cannot be extended). In order to enter Peru it is indispensable to carry a valid passport.

#### 3.2. Vaccination

There are no mandatory vaccines for entry into Peru. Should you wish to visit the Amazonian region of the country, the Ministry of Health recommends vaccinations against yellow fever, in this case the vaccination against yellow fever must be administered at least 10 days before the date of travel to be effective.

## 3.3. Currency

The "Sol" is the official currency of Peru. Countless shops, restaurants, hotels and gas stations normally accept US Dollars.

It is possible to exchange currency in banks and currency exchange agencies (Currency exchange agencies are regularly open from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm, from Monday to Friday, and half day on Saturdays). There are also "cambistas" street currency exchangers in Miraflores, but the safety of the transaction is not guaranteed.

The currently money exchange is around S/.3.28 per US dollar and S/.3.85 per euro, check here the official exchange rate:

Credit cards can also be used, and most districts in the city have ATMs connected in most cases to Plus (Visa), Cirrus (MasterCard/Maestro), American Express and other networks.

#### 3.8. Transport from airport to hotel

Jorge Chávez International Airport (Lima) is located 16 km (10 miles) to the northwest of Lima. Hotels are located in Miraflores and San Isidro the best option is reach them by taxi. Many taxis are available at the airport but we recommended to our participants use the services of Taxis which has a small desks located outside the arrivals hall, behind the car rental booths. Rates are posted beside this desk. The journey takes about 50 minutes and the cost is approximately 35-50 Soles (maximum 20 dollars); most taxis accept both: Soles and US dollars.



# 3.9. Moving around on your own

For transport in Lima, we recommend our participants to arrange for taxis at the hotel reception. Or you have the option to coordinate a service by phone, for example Taxi Satelital, Tel: 355-5555 (They will pick you up in 5-15 minutes, approximately), or utilize the applications Uber or EasyTaxi.







Lima is located on the west central coast of Peru, on the shores of the Pacific Ocean, Lima's history predates the colonial presence in the country. The establishment of the viceroyalty transformed the city into the important political and administrative center of South America. During this period, significant churches, monasteries, mansions and balconies were built. he arrival of modernity didn't transform the historic center, which is recognized as a World Heritage Site.

Museums with great works of art, archaeological sites, beaches, the boardwalk, valleys, natural reserves, the nightlife, the thrill of adventure sports, and the exquisite cuisine gives Peru's capital an authentic personality and makes tourism in Lima a unique experience in the country.
