CRP – Ministerial segment of CPM-15 (2020)

The Ministerial segment¹ of the fifteenth session of the Commission on Phytosanitary Measures (CPM-15) is planned as a key event in the International Year of Plant Health (IYPH) in 2020.

It was agreed by CPM-13 (2018)² to raise the profile of the IPPC and ensure the strongest possible endorsement of the new IPPC strategic framework.

The CPM Ministerial segment will provide a focus on the critical role of the Convention in preventing the international movement of plant pests and their impacts on food security, trade and the environment.

The key actions for the Ministers will be the adoption of the IPPC Strategic Framework 2020-2030 and related Ministerial Declaration on the importance of Plant Health, which will direct the implementation of efficient, contemporary and innovative initiatives by the IPPC community to meet the challenges posed by increasing movements of people, goods and pests in the 21st century.

IPPC contracting parties are urged to begin preparations for their respective Minister's participation as soon as possible for this very important event.
