This justifies the need to (i) formulate a Regional Action Plan to prevent, monitor and respond to Foc TR4; (ii) elaborate and adopt National Action Plans to respond, monitor and prevent Foc TR4; and (iii) develop and implement a capacity strengthening plan to contribute to preventing, responding and monitoring Foc TR4 as an essential element for the ownership and sustainability of all these actions.
