





- conduct of pest risk analysis for the importation of regulated plants and plant products




Responsibilities (cont.)


Responsibilities (cont.)

- inspection and clearance of consignments of baggage, cargo, mail, carriers, plants and plant products entering through Thailand ports of entry to prevent the introduction and/or spread of pests

Plant Quarantine Import Requirements

- Prohibited materials
- Restricted materials
- Unprohibited materials





Prohibited materials:

- Plants & plant products/ shipped from areas specify designated by the Ministerial Notification
- plants, plant pests and diseases and carriers
- soil and organic fertilizer

Exception are permitted by DOA for experimentation or research only

Requirements:

- imported via 3 plant quarantine stations
- phytosanitary certificate issued by NPPO of the exporting country
- phytosanitary certificate :
declare that the consignment is free from plant quarantine pest and disease





Restricted materials:

- plants & plant products designated by the Ministerial Notification


Requirements:

- phytosanitary certificate issued by government of the exporting country



Requirements: cont.

- handled according to conditions prescribe by plant quarantine officer
- plants intended for propagation must be subjected to thorough examination





Unprohibited material:

plant materials other than prohibited and restricted materials

- permission and a PC are not required
- have to be notified for inspection at port entry
- inspection, treatment or destruction if plant quarantine pests and disease are found


